

A Message from Mayor Wax

We urge you to use these letters, and information posted on City/Town/County web sites, as an accurate source of information coming from the Long-Term Recovery (LTR) and other government and disaster recovery-related meetings.

1. Debris

- a. Last pass for curbside debris removal has been extended to March 14.

 Remember to separate your piles into vegetation, building materials and appliances. As mentioned before, the sweep will begin in the north end of the county and move southward.
- b. Currently, Crowder Gulf is sweeping *demolition piles*. Please call the Long Term Recovery Center at 361-790-9496 if you're planning a full demolition to schedule clean-up.

2. Funding and Assistance

- a. If you need assistance with property clean up, repairs, and moving mobile/manufactured housing, please contact the Volunteer Reception Center at First Baptist Church. They keep a master list of residents needing assistance and match them with incoming volunteer groups. All Hands & Hearts, a volunteer group that had been working in Portland, will now be helping here.
- b. Owners of multi-family dwellings who were unable to attend the special meeting with the General Land Office may view it online at www.rockportfultondisasterrecovery.com.
- c. **Coastal Bend Disaster Recovery Group** has hired Warren Phipps, a resident of Portland, as Executive Director. Phipps retired from service with the Army as a major general. During his career he was a divisional commander and oversaw the operation of several installations.

3. Recovery Updates.

- a. **Texas Department of Emergency Management** is setting up a Hazard Mitigation team. City Manager Kevin Carruth will represent Rockport.
- b. **Housing.** Seven builders and two developers have been talking with the City about prospective Workforce Housing.

PLEASE call 811 or visit Dig Tess online to have underground utility lines marked and identified free of charge --before any excavation or major plantings on individual properties.
- c. Spectrum announced today that is has upgraded and replaced 36 miles of underground network and will continue its work through the County.
- d. Congratulations to the **Rockport-Fulton Pirates basketball team** for advancing to area playoffs.
- e. **Oysterfest**, sponsored by the Fulton Volunteer Fire Department, will be held March 1 4.
