H. 35 Bypass, Rockport, Texas, to consider recommendations from the Code Official that the Building and Standards Commission order building(s) demolished, for property located at 616 Young St., also known as West one-half of Out Lot 27, Doughty & Mathis Division, currently owned by Julia Gabbert and Yvette Webb, Rockport, Aransas County, Texas: Improvement/Building, 902.0 total square feet, main area 902.0 sq. ft., Covered Porch 84.0 sq. ft., Open Porch 24.00 sq. ft.

Purpose of the meeting is to review violations of the City of Rockport, Chapter 22, Buildings and Building Regulations, Article X Unsafe Building Abatement, Section 22-347; conditions constituting a substandard or dangerous building, which includes but is not limited to, unsecured doors and/or broken windows, 50 percent or more damage or deterioration of the nonsporting enclosing or outside walls or covering, damage to structure by wind, or elements of nature.
