



## PUBLIC HEARING

### Zoning Board of Adjustment

NOTICE is hereby given that the Zoning Board of Adjustment will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, March 29, 2021, at 5:30 p.m., to consider a request for relief from the Zoning Ordinance for property located at 913 Patton Street; also known as McDavid Manor Subdivision, Block 1, Lot 1, being 0.846 acre, City of Rockport, Aransas County, Texas. The purpose of the request is for a variance to the City's front and rear yard setbacks as per the property's R-1 (1<sup>st</sup> Single Family Dwelling District) designation.

The meeting will be held using the video conferencing application ZOOM. No in-person meeting will be conducted at the Rockport Service Center. A temporary suspension of the Open Meetings Act to allow telephone or video conference public meetings has been granted by Governor Greg Abbott. These actions are being taken to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 by avoiding meetings that bring people into a group setting and in accordance with Section 418.016 of the Texas Government Code. Video conferencing capabilities will be utilized to allow individuals to address the Zoning Board of Adjustment. Members of the public can participate in the meeting remotely by using the ZOOM address that will be provided on the Zoning Board of Adjustment Agenda of March 29, 2021 and posted on the City's website [www.cityofrockport.com](http://www.cityofrockport.com).

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the attorney general has said: "statutes that may be interpreted to require face-to-face interaction between members of the public and public officials are suspended; provided, however, that the governmental bodies must offer alternative methods of communicating with their public officials." The comments will be read and summarized in the minutes of the meeting.
