The Building and Standards Commission will consider recommendations from the City of Rockport Code Enforcement Officer to order building(s) demolished on the following properties:

711 South Ann Street, also known as Lots 3-5, Block Outlot 26, Doughty & Mathis Outlots, Rockport, Aransas County, Texas; currently owned by Robert Garcia.

405 East Bay Street, also known as Lot 5 & 50' x 30' Strip of Reserve Adjacent to Lot 5, Block West 1/2 of Outlot 26, Spencer Subdivision, Rockport, Aransas County, Texas; currently owned by Ismael Gonzales Jr. and Reyna L. Martinez.
